Days 1: Bergen, embarkation Your journey begins in Bergen,

'The City of Seven Mountains,' renowned for its colourful wooden wharves and bustling fish market.

Day 2: Florø - Molde

Sail through idyllic fjords, pastislets and skerries to the stylish town of Ålesund and its distinctive Art Nouveau architecture.

Day 3: Kristiansund - Rørvik

Visit Nidaros Cathedral,Norway's most famous church,and stroll through the charming Bakklandet district in the old Viking city of Trondheim.

Days 4: Brønnøysund - Svolvær

Join us out on deck for a traditional ceremony to mark crossing the Arctic Circle. You're now in the realm of winter's Northern Lights and summer's Midnight Sun.

Day 5: Stokmarknes - Skjervøy

Learn about the culture and polar history on a city walk. Visit the striking Arctic Cathedral. Or take the Fjellheisen Cable Car up the Storsteinen Mountain.

Day 6: Øksfjord - Berlevåg

Having reached the famed "northernmost point of Europe", visit the iconic globe monument and the North Cape Hall.

Day 7: Båtsfjord - Kirkenes-Berlevåg

You'll see abundant birdlife on along the sea cliffs. Look for little auks, puffins, black-legged kittiwakes, and fulmars.

Day 8: Mehamn - Tromsø

At a 78°N, you're less than 820 miles from the North Pole. Home to just 2,000 inhabitants, visit the galleries, pubs, brewery, and North Pole Expedition Museum.

Day 9: Tromsø - Stamsund

See the unspoilt beauty of the fabled Vesterålen and Lofotenislands. Admire the dramatic scenery from out on deck or on an optional excursion.

Day 10: Bodø - Rørvik

The stunning Helgeland coast awaits, including the Seven Sisters mountain range and Torghatten Mountain, pierced by a natural tunnel.

Day 11: Trondheim - Until next time

The ship arrives in Trondheim early in the morning. It'll be time to say your goodbyes to the new-found friends you made on board, including the Captain, crew, and fellow guests.


